Placement Text

- If you can't translate any of this text:

- If you can translate most of the text slowly, with effort or a few missing words:
 - → Join "Activate Your French." You're ready to speak, make mistakes, and grow your fluency.
- If you can translate the whole text with little difficulty, maybe even rephrase it in fluent French:
 - → Join "Engage with French." You can handle complex ideas now it's time to deepen your fluency through real discussions.
